## **Mandatory Documents:**

- 1. Duly completed UAE Visa Application Form
- 2. Coloured passport data page (valid for at least 6 months)
- 3. Front cover page of passport
- 4. One coloured passport-sized photograph (white background)
- 5. Confirmed onward or return Emirates Airline ticket (applicant's name highlighted)
- 6. Hotel booking confirmation in UAE (dates must match flight itinerary)
- 7. Valid visa for the destination country after leaving UAE
- 8. Marriage certificate (for couples) and birth certificates (for children)
- 9. For non-Nigerian nationals valid residence permit (CERPAC)
- 10. Bank statement for applicants aged 18–41 years:

Minimum balance of \$10,000 per month (individual) \$20,000 (family joint account)

- 11. Proof of sufficient funds at point of entry
- 12. Additional documents may be requested at the discretion of the visa officer

Note: Emirates cannot sponsor unaccompanied minors or students unless traveling with parents.

# **Mandatory Documents:**

- 1. Completed UAE Visa Application Form
- 2. Confirmed Emirates onward/return ticket (dates matching hotel booking)
- 3. One coloured passport-sized photograph (white background)
- 4. Passport data page and front cover page (valid 6 months minimum)
- 5. Confirmed hotel booking (check-in and check-out dates highlighted)
- 6. Valid visa for destination country (if traveling onward)
- 7. If visiting family/friends:

Tenancy contract (Ejari) or property deed

UAE Resident ID card of the host

Proof of relationship (birth/marriage certificate)

- 8. For non-Nigerian nationals valid CERPAC / residence permit
- 9. Bank statement for applicants aged 18–41 years:

Individual – \$10,000 minimum monthly balance

Family (joint) – \$20,000 minimum monthly balance

- 10. Marriage certificate (for couples) and birth certificates (for children)
- 11. Proof of financial capacity at entry
- 12. Additional documents if requested by the Embassy

Note: Emirates does not sponsor unaccompanied minors or students. All minors must travel with their parent.
